

## CRAN License Transition schedule

**Submission to be made sixty (60) days after commencement of the Communications Act, i.e. by Sunday, the 18<sup>th</sup> of July 2011.**

<b>Existing Unlicensed Service Providers</b>	Information Form to be Submitted by Persons Lawfully Providing Services Without a Licence.
<b>Pending License Applications</b>	Information Form to be Submitted by Persons with Pending Applications submitted to the Namibian Communications Commission (NCC).

**Submission ninety (90) days after commencement of the Communications Act, i.e. by Tuesday, the 16<sup>th</sup> of August 2011.**

<b>Entity/Party</b>	<b>Submission</b>
<b>Existing Service Providers</b>	Interconnection agreements (both domestic and international) that existed at the commencement of the Act, with a cover letter containing specific contact information. New interconnection agreements are to be submitted in terms of the deadlines set out in the Act.

**Submission six (6) months after commencement of the Communications Act, i.e. by Tuesday, the 18<sup>th</sup> of November 2011.**

<b>Entity/Party</b>	<b>Submission</b>
<b>Namibian Defence Force and any other Organ of State contemplated in section 101(12) of the Act</b>	Application Form for the Use of Spectrum for Defence Purposes.
<b>Telecom Namibia Limited</b>	Application Form to Amend the Deemed Application provided for in sections 45(1) and 101(9) of the Act.
<b>Persons Lawfully Providing Services without a license as contemplated in section 135(5) of the Act, including Namibian Broadcasting Corporation</b>	Application Form
<b>Existing Services Providers</b>	Parties must submit tariffs containing all of the required information as set out in the "Regulations regarding the submission of interconnections agreements and tariffs".
