



Is your equipment Type Approved

Type Approval regulations are applicable to all persons who use, sell, offer for sale or connect telecommunications equipment to an electronic telecommunications network within the Republic of Namibia.

The process of authorising and verifying the use of all
telecommunications equipment, ensuring it conforms to the
applicable technical standards set by CRAN.
All applicants must submit the application form that can be
found in the Type Approval regulations on CRAN's website.
A Type Approval certificate is valid for a period of 3 years
and may be renewed after the period lapses.
The Authority may seize non type approved
telecommunications equipment that does not comply with
the applicable technical standards as set by CRAN.
The period for any service provider to obtain their Type
Approval certificate ends on 31 April 2016.

Remember, as an ICT Service Provider, you have a right to sell any telecommunications equipment of your choice, but you have a responsibility to ensure that you only sell authentic, type approved telecommunications equipment.
