

Public Notice



The Communications Regulatory Authority of Namibia herewith gives notice that it has published the following notices in **Government Gazette No. 5692; General Notices No. 122 - 125, dated 20 March 2015:**

A. AMENDMENT TO REGULATIONS

1. Notice in terms of Regulation 4 of the Regulations Regarding Rule Making Procedures

- 1.1 Notice that the Authority intends to **amend the effective date of the Regulations in respect of Type Approval and Technical Standards for Telecommunications Equipment: Communications Act, 2009**, which was published in the Government Gazette No. 5659, General Notice No.22 dated 30 January 2015.
- 1.2 The purpose of the proposed amendment is to change the effective date of the regulations and also to allow for a transition period within which all applicants will ensure that they obtain type approval certificates.

The Public may submit comments in writing to the Authority within a period of seven (7) days from the **20th of March 2015** in respect of the above notice.

B. NEW TARIFF SUBMISSIONS

2. Notice in terms of section 53 (7) of the Communications Act (Act No. 8 of 2009)

- 2.1 Notice that **Mobile Telecommunications Limited** has submitted **Data Bundle Tariffs** to the Authority for approval.
- 2.2 Notice that **Telecom Namibia Limited** has submitted **Fixed Mobile Convergence Tariffs** to the Authority for approval.

The Public may submit comments in writing to the Authority within a period of fourteen (14) days from the **20th of March 2015** in respect of the above notices.

C. WITHDRAWAL OF LICENCE APPLICATIONS

3. Notice in terms of Regulation 19 of the Regulations Regarding Licensing Procedures for Telecommunications and Broadcasting Service Licences and Spectrum Use Licences

- 3.1 Notice that the **Muslim Community Radio FM** has withdrawn its Spectrum Use Licence and Community Broadcasting Service Licence applications. Please note that the Authority will no longer consider these applications and wishes to notify the public that that the file is closed accordingly.
