PHISHERS



Phishing is when someone tries to trick you into giving them information, such as your password. Someone might also try to trick you, by saying they can make you famous or that they're from a talent agency. Be alert and use clues to help differentiate between what is real and what is fake.



Never click links from emails or messages that require you to log in or share your details, even if you think it may be genuine. If you're requested to log into a website, rather go to the app or site directly. If something sounds too good to be true, it probably isn't.
