



Child Online Protection

PRIVACY



Don't share personal details such as your phone number, home address or your location, and regularly update your privacy settings. Remember that people can use small clues such as a school logo in a photo to find out a lot about you.



Keep your device and information secure. Never share your password or log-in details, bank account and card details or other personal information such as your number. Make sure you pick strong and easy to remember passwords to protect your accounts from unauthorized access.



Select strong passwords that are at least 8 characters and cannot be easily guessed. Use numbers and symbols to create strong passwords.



Cover your webcam when not in use, as some spyware will enable others to access your webcam without you knowing. Your phone's camera can use GPS tracking to pinpoint the location on your phone and identify your location.
