NOTICE IN TERMS OF REGULATION 19(1) OF THE REGULATIONS REGARDING LICENSING PROCEDURES FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND BROADCASTING SERVICE LICENCES: COMMUNICATIONS ACT, 2009

The Communications Regulatory Authority of Namibia, in terms of regulation 19(1) of the Regulations Regarding Licensing Procedures for Telecommunications and Broadcasting Service Licences, published in Government Gazette No. 4785, as General Notice No. 272, on 29 August 2011 (as amended), hereby gives notice of the following decisions:

Telecommunications Service Licences

- The Authority resolved to award a Class Network Facilities Service Licence to **FMT Global Connect Namibia Holdings (Pty) Ltd.**
- The Authority resolved to award a Class Comprehensive Telecommunications Service Licence (ECS & ECNS) to **Oryx Fibre Infrastructure (Pty) Ltd.**

- c) The Authority resolved to award a Class Comprehensive Telecommunications Service Licence (ECS & ECNS) to **Packet Information Technologies CC**.
