The Communications Regulatory Authority of Namibia, in terms of regulation 19(1) of the Regulations regarding Licensing Procedures for Telecommunications and Broadcasting Service Licences, published as General Notice 272, in Government Gazette No. 4785, on 29 August 2011 (as amended) and regulation 34(1) of the Regulations prescribing Procedures regarding Application for, and Amendment, Renewal, Transfer and Cancellation of Spectrum Licences, published as General Notice. 104, in Government Gazette No. 6888, on 29 April 2019, hereby gives notice of the following decisions:

**Telecommunications Service Licence:**
