

The Communications Regulatory Authority of Namibia herewith gives notice that it has published the following Notice in the Government *Gazette* No.5343; General Notice No. 430-435, dated 14th of November 2013:

## A. LICENCE AWARDS

### 1. Notice in Terms of the Regulations Regarding Licensing Procedures for Telecommunications and Broadcasting Service Licences and Spectrum Use Licences

- 1.1 Notice that **HRT Africa Petroleo S.A.** has been awarded a Spectrum Use Licence, for the provision of private fixed satellite services, effective from the date of publication of this Notice in the Government *Gazette*.

## B. NEW APPLICATIONS

### 2. Notice in terms of the Regulations Regarding Licensing Procedures for Telecommunications and Broadcasting Service Licences and Spectrum Use Licences:

- 2.1 Notice that **Comprehensive Nuclear Test-Ban Treaty Organization (CTBTO)** has submitted an application for a Spectrum Use Licence.
- 2.2 Notice that **NAMDEB Diamond Corporation (Pty) Ltd** has applied for Amendment to its Spectrum Use Licence with the Authority as set out in Schedule 1 of the Notice.

## D. LICENCE MODIFICATIONS

### 4. Notice in terms of Section 42 (2) of the Communications Act, No. 8 of 2009 read with the Regulations Regarding Licensing Procedures for Telecommunications and Broadcasting Service Licences and Spectrum Use Licences:

- 4.1 **Capricorn Radio CC** was assigned with the frequency 102.3 MHz for the geographical area of Rehoboth as published in the Government *Gazette* No. 5179, General Notice No. 114, of 17 April 2013;
- 4.2 The Authority assigned the frequency of 102.3 MHz to **Capricorn Radio CC** erroneously. The said frequency was already assigned to another licensee, namely Media for Christ (section 21 association not for gain) on the 13th of September 2012 in terms of Government *Gazette* No. 5037, General Notice No. 306 of 13 September 2012.
- 4.3 The Authority identified 96.1 MHz as an alternative frequency for assignment to **Capricorn Radio CC**. The assignment of the new frequency will be effective from the date of publication of this Notice.

The public may submit comments in writing to the Authority within a period of fourteen (14) days from the date of publication of the Notice in the Government *Gazette*.
