

The Communications Regulatory Authority of Namibia herewith gives notice that it has published the following notice in the Government Gazette No. 5201; General Notices No. 162-163 dated 31st of May 2013:

1. Notice in terms of Regulation Regarding Rule-Making Procedures: Communications Act

1.1 Notice that the Authority has published Regulations Setting Out The Frequency Band Plan for the Republic of Namibia, which will be in force and effective from date of publication in the Government Gazette.

A band plan is a plan for using a particular band of radio frequencies, that are a portion of the electromagnetic spectrum. It defines the frequency range to be included, how channels are to be defined, and what will be carried on those channels.

1.2 Notice that the Authority has published a Notice of Intention to Make Regulations in respect of Type Approval and Technical Standards for Electronic Telecommunications Equipment.

The public may submit comments in writing to the Authority within a period of thirty (30) days from the date of publication of the notice in the Government Gazette in respect of the Notice listed under 1.2 above.
